Please be advised that there has been a minor update to the *Outcome Measures – Adult* form.
Admin Teams: please proceed with ordering the new version of this form.

HoNOS item number 8 ‘*Other mental & behavioural problems*’ requires **both** a Letter rating and a Score rating to be valid.

The form has been updated to reflect this requirement:

HoNOS Rating Period: previous 2 weeks for Ambulatory and Residential services. Previous 3 days on discharge from Inpatient services. Scoring: 0 = No problem, 1 = Minor problem-no action, 2 = Mild problem-definitely present, 3 = Moderately Severe Problem, 4 = Severe/Very Severe Problem, 9 = Not known/NA Question 8: A - Phobic, B - Anxiety, C - OCD, D - Stress, E - Dissociative, F - Somatoform, G - Eating, H - Sleep, I - Sexual, J - Other			Outcome Measure

Please note: collection of a consumer’s Phase of Care (PoC) is required

1. On Admission, intake, and on review
2. When there is a change in the consumer’s clinical needs
 e.g. ACIS to case management, community to IP

When there is a change in Phase of Care, the full suite of OMs is required i.e. HoNOS, LSP-16 (except for inpatient), BASIS-32
